

Family Services

Westhab delivers the supportive services needed for families to secure suitable affordable housing, achieve self-sufficiency, and attain a high quality of life. We work with families holistically to ensure that all needs are met and that they have the skills needed to achieve their goals.

Programs:

- **Coachman Family Center** - 100 family capacity Tier II homeless shelter offering comprehensive services.
- **Emergency Housing Apartment Program**- Scattered site homeless apartment program used as a transition from shelter to permanent housing.
- **Apartment Finding Initiative**- Assists homeless residents County-wide in locating and securing permanent housing.
- **Elm Street Community Resource Center**- A one-stop community resource in southwest Yonkers meeting changing community needs.

- Moves over **200** homeless families into permanent housing each year; over **5,000** in our history.
- Provides comprehensive Youth Services, Employment Counseling and Job Placement, Life Skills, and Housing Assistance to all resident families.
- Utilizes a *Housing First* approach, prioritizing obtaining sustainable affordable housing throughout the service delivery process.
