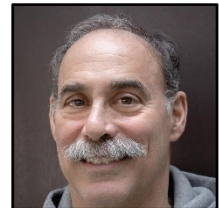
Ken Hanau – Managing Director, Industrial Sector Head – Bain Capital

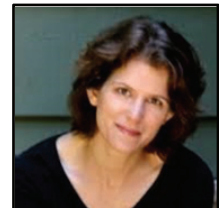
David Katz – Principal, MacArthur Holdings, LLC
