Shelter Plus Care (S+C)

Westhab participates in the Westchester County Department

of Community Mental Health's Shelter Plus Care Family and Single adult Program. Through this program Westhab provides - 32 families and 17 Single adults with a mental health diagnosis - with up to five years of subsidized housing.

The Westhab Shelter Plus Care Family Program provides case management and life-skills assistance to all participants. Participants are placed in a scattered site apartment throughout the County and are offered assistance in obtaining other housing subsidies - including Section 8 vouchers - so that they can become self-sufficient.

Westhab case managers coordinate additional services with other community organizations including out-patient mental health treatment, substance abuse treatment, vocational training and assistance with educational needs. Westhab also provides the support needed in maintaining a healthy living environment within the community. Our goal is to help families and single veterans acquire the skills and services needed to sustain independent living in their own permanent housing.
